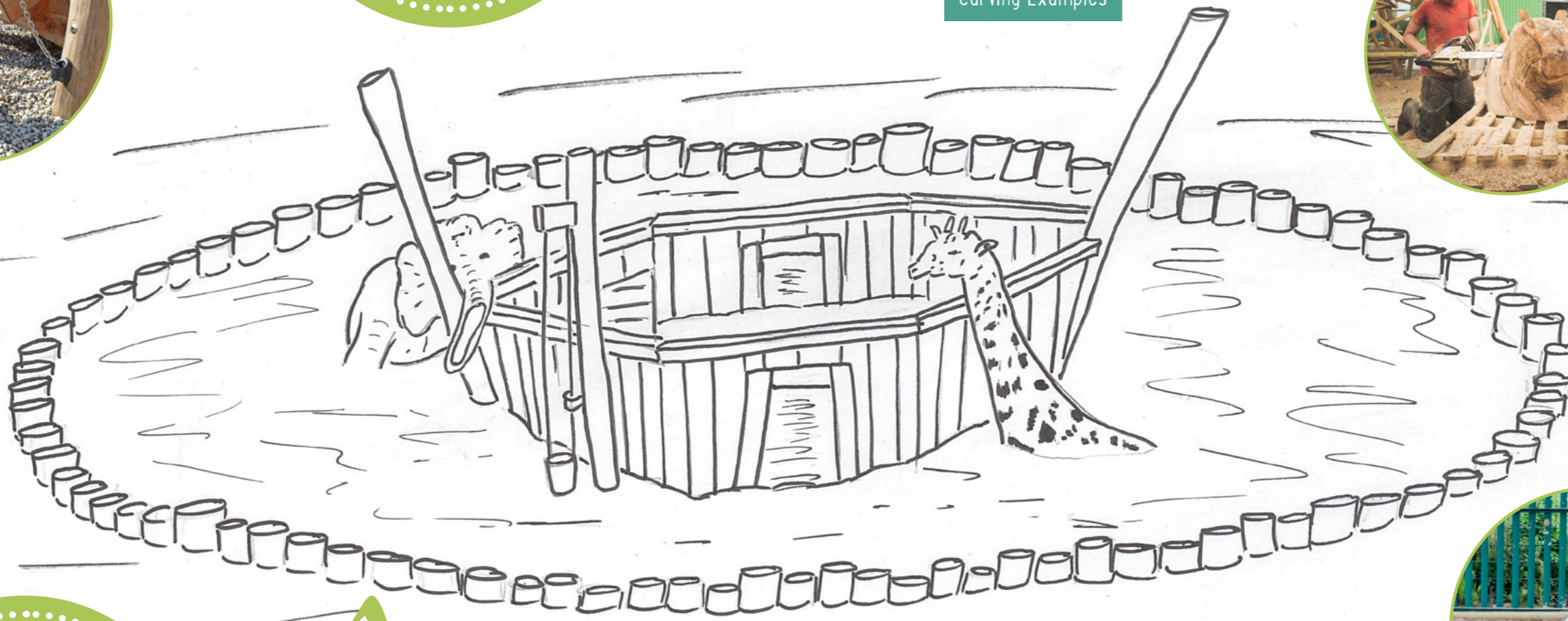


SAND PIT ZONE

DESIGN RATIONALE

We have talented chainsaw artists who can carve a multiple array of woodland animals or creatures! The carvings also offer a sensory experience as children can touch and feel the different textures.

DESIGN RATIONALE

A vertical pulley allows children to transport for a purpose using a pulley system, developing problem solving and co-operation skills. The pulley system uses high quality stainless steel marine mechanisms with a chain and rubber bucket.

Sand play

Utilising the existing sand pit area we have proposed a new feature that includes fully enclosed low timber walls with a crawl through entrance. Children love to dig, build, sort, sprinkle and explore in our timber edged sandpits. Children learn through sensory experience and freedom to explore through manipulation and experimentation is essential for healthy development. We have included bespoke carvings of two of the animals that the Dukes of Devonshire used to keep on the grounds, and elephant and a giraffe. There is a sand chute carved into the elephants trunk so as well as an aesthetic feature, the elephant provides tactile, sensory and interactive play opportunities.
